The Vicar Writes...

Well, now we know, what can we do?

Those of you who live in the third of Sticklepath with Roundswell that is in the Tawstock Civil parish were invited to fill in a questionnaire this spring. The council kindly allowed the churches to contribute a page in between all the questions about parking and planning permission. The result were released to me last week. We have put them onto a computer spreadsheet (they are all anonymous) and did some analysis. A clear picture of some community care & support needs has emerged.

Most of those who answered were in the age ranges 60yrs and upward. No-one under 30 answered, and there were not enough answering in each range of the 30s, 40s & 50s for proper analysis of those age ranges. We will try an on-line survey in a few months to fill in some gaps.

The results are only statistically valid for those aged 60 plus, but there were a number of relevant questions which showed a huge response. As a church we had already agreed that developing ministry to better serve this group was necessary, but we can't do so without the partnership of other voluntary groups and local residents. So please turn to the centre pages for more information about the analysed results (also on our website) and consider if you could help as well.
